Gould Construction Institute Obtains Sheet Metal Schooling License

The Gould Construction Institute (GCI) was recently granted their school sheet metal license, by the Board of Examiners of Sheet Metal Workers. In 2008 legislation was signed into law that began regulating the sheet metal trade. Although GCI has taught sheet metal trade courses for several years now; their new curriculum has been fully vetted by the state and will accommodate any worker looking to be fully licensed.

Barbara Lagergren, President of GCI, looks forward to being able to offer students greater opportunities to further their construction careers. "Today's construction industry needs schools like GCI that have the flexibility and resources to provide workers with the training and education they need," Lagergren said.

GCI is the first proprietary school in Massachusetts to earn their license since sheet metal became a regulated trade. However, GCI has been approved by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education for over 15 years for sheet metal training.

For the school year 2010-2011, GCI will be offering their "Sheet Metal 2" class which consists of 150-168 classroom and hands on training hours covering mathematics to sheet metal duct fabrication standards to basic piping practices to name a few.
